Computer and Information Systems Managers, also known as IT managers, oversee an organization's technology infrastructure and information systems. They plan, coordinate, and direct computer-related activities, ensuring that IT resources support business goals efficiently and securely. Their role combines technical expertise with strategic management.

Duties and Responsibilities (Points):

- Plan, develop, and implement IT strategies and systems
- Manage IT staff, including hiring, training, and performance evaluation
- Oversee network security, data management, and system integrity
- Coordinate software development, installation, and maintenance
- Monitor IT budgets and resource allocation
- Ensure compliance with technology-related regulations and standards
- Troubleshoot complex IT problems and provide technical guidance
- Collaborate with other departments to support organizational objectives
- Evaluate emerging technologies and recommend improvements
- Prepare reports on system performance, security, and IT projects
