Duties and Responsibilities (Points):

- Manage project budgets, resources, and procurement of materials
- Ensure compliance with safety, building codes, and quality standards
- Monitor project progress and resolve issues or delays
- Review and interpret architectural and engineering plans
- Coordinate with clients, architects, engineers, and suppliers
- Conduct site inspections and quality control checks
- Prepare reports, documentation, and progress updates
