They facilitate the smooth movement of goods across borders, ensuring compliance with regulations, proper documentation, and timely delivery. Their role is essential in international trade and logistics.

Duties and Responsibilities (Points):

- Prepare and submit documentation for import/export of goods
- Ensure compliance with customs regulations, tariffs, and trade laws
- Calculate duties, taxes, and fees applicable to shipments
- Coordinate with shipping companies, freight forwarders, and government agencies
- Track shipments and manage logistics for timely delivery
- Advise clients on import/export procedures, restrictions, and costs
- Resolve issues related to customs clearance or shipment delays
- Maintain accurate records of transactions, shipments, and payments
- Negotiate shipping rates and transportation arrangements
- Stay updated on changes in trade regulations, tariffs, and documentation requirements
