Government Managers in this category plan, coordinate, and oversee programs and policies related to economic analysis, public policy, and program administration. They ensure that government initiatives are effective, efficient, and aligned with legislative and societal objectives. Their work involves research, strategic planning, and leadership to support public service and policy implementation.

Duties and Responsibilities (Points):

- Develop, implement, and evaluate government programs and policies
- Conduct economic and policy analysis to inform decision-making
- Monitor program performance and ensure compliance with regulations
- Prepare reports, briefings, and policy recommendations for senior officials
- Supervise and coordinate teams of analysts, officers, and administrative staff
- Collaborate with other government departments, agencies, and stakeholders
- Advise policymakers on economic trends, policy impacts, and program effectiveness
- Manage budgets, resources, and operational planning for programs
- Develop strategies for public service delivery and community engagement
- Stay updated on legislation, economic developments, and best practices in public administration
