- Supervise and coordinate teams involved in program delivery and policy implementation
- Collaborate with healthcare providers, social services, and community organizations
- Manage budgets, resources, and operational planning for programs
- Assess program effectiveness and recommend improvements
- Advise policymakers on public health initiatives, social welfare, and community services
- Stay updated on health trends, social issues, legislation, and best practices in policy administration
