Duties and Powers:

- Ensure compliance with safety, environmental, and regulatory standards.
- Coordinate with contractors, suppliers, and government agencies.
- Monitor project progress, production output, or service delivery and take corrective actions.
- Approve contracts, project plans, and resource allocations.
- Identify risks and implement mitigation strategies.
- Represent the organization in stakeholder meetings, negotiations, and industry forums.
